

Associations Incorporation Reform Act 2012

Section 1: Name

The name of the incorporated association is Mornington Peninsula Veteran Golfers Association Incorporated.

Section 2: Purposes

The purposes of the association are

- a) To promote the game of golf, and other sports, games and pastimes
- b) To provide registered financial members of designated Mornington Peninsula Golf Clubs the opportunity to be members of the Association subject to its rules and work to foster relationship developments with those member clubs including holding events at same
- c) To promote and hold, either alone or jointly with any other Association, Club or persons, golf and other sports meetings, competitions, and matches, and to offer, give or contribute towards prizes, medals and awards, and to promote, give or support dinners, balls, concerts, and other entertainments
- d) To establish, promote or assist in establishing or promoting, and to subscribe or become a member of or co-operate with any other association or club whose objects are similar or in part similar to the objects of the Association, the establishment or promotion of which may be beneficial to this Association
- e) To raise money by entrance fees and subscriptions as established by the Committee from time to time, and to grant any rights and privileges to subscribers
- f) To invest and deal with the monies of the Association not immediately required upon such securities and in such manner as may from time to time be determined
- g) To do all such things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of all or any of the above objects

Section 3: Financial Year

The financial year of the Association is each period of 12 months ending on 31 December.

Section 4: Constitution

MPVGA has adopted the Model Association Rules as outlined in the Associations Incorporation Reform Act 2012 (see Victorian Government website for details of same).
