Moonah Open Report.

We had 47 players turn out to contest the 2<sup>nd</sup> round of the Presidents/Captains Trophy at Moonah Open on Monday 1st of September 2025. By the results I can only guess the course played tricky. Congratulations to the winners on the day, A Grade winner, with 38 Pts was Nick Sayle and B Grade was Robert Whiting with 39 Pts.

I had the pleasure of playing in the AVGA Championships in Darwin that week, accompanied by Peter Skidmore. I contacted John on the morning of 1<sup>st</sup> to let him know of a pull out for Moonah and he assured me everything was going well, but it was very cold. I didn't have the heart to tell him that at around 8.00am on the Monday in Darwin it was 28c.

On the Monday we played 4BBB at Palmerston golf course. The course had been hosting the NT PGA, finishing on the Sunday, and the pin positions had not been moved for the Monday, so the course played hard. After golf a welcome get together was had on the lawns of the Darwin casino, giving us a great chance to meet our fellow competitors. The Tuesday was the official start of the 3-round championship. We teed off in the morning field at Darwin golf course. The course was set up long and a real challenge. Wednesday was a rest day giving us a chance to explore part of the top end and meet some of the locals. Please see attached photo. Thursday was the most difficult for me, as we were in the afternoon tee group, with a 1.45pm start in 35c temperatures at Palmerston. The course played hard, and a lot of water was consumed. Friday was the last round at Darwin, and with an 8.00am tee time was much more pleasant. I am sure whoever set the courses up for the event forgot we were all vets, as both courses played long with some very tricky pin positions. At 7.00pm a presentation dinner was held at the Darwin Sailing club with guest speakers, including Aaron Pike, who's insight into the touring professional's life was an eye opener.

The event was very well set up and organised. I would recommend everyone try to be a part of the AVGA event at least once. Next year it is on the Gold Coast.

Our next game is Cerberus 1 tee start from 8.30. Cost will be \$32 and \$5 for members. Carts are to be booked through the pro shop and paid for on the day. Check in will be from 7.45. Please arrive and be ready to play at least 15mins before your tee time. Earlier if you have not paid. Always check the start sheet the night before as times may change due to operational requirements. I do need to move people around at times, I do try to keep people I know play with regular partners together,

so when you get an email saying your booking has been cancelled, please wait a few minutes for another telling you that you are booked in.

It helps when players pay online prior to the event. Please check your prize/credits online and only pay the difference. To check your balance just click on member home then prizes. Please remember to keep up with the group ahead of you.




