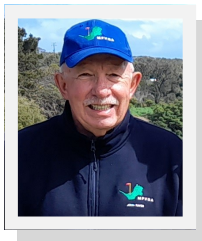

Goldfields Challenge - Event Summary

Members of MPVGA received an invitation from Bendigo to attend the Goldfields Challenge, which took place on the 22nd and 23rd of September. With Ed Gill's connection to Bendigo in mind, the decision was made to attend, leading to a memorable couple of days in Central Victoria.

The plan involved an early drive on Monday to make the 10:00AM tee off, followed by a retreat to a motel for rest and socialising. Some members arrived Sunday afternoon, though a few regretted the early celebrations!

Upon checking in on the first morning, it was clear that many MPVGA members had the same idea, with at least ten present, sporting the familiar blue tee-shirts. Attendees came from various clubs, including Devilbend, PK, and Mount Martha.

The Bendigo course is notably long, but flat and picturesque. It was in good condition, albeit a little dry. The \$80 entry fee covered two days of golf and a welcome bag on day one containing a ham roll, chocolate, water, and a marker from Bendigo Golf Club. After a few drinks, members settled in for an early night to prepare for day two.

Day two began with an egg and bacon roll, followed by cold meat and salad after completing the round. The value provided was outstanding.

Results and Reflections

After the first day, James Hardie claimed the B Grade win, with Ed Gill close behind in second place. Day two saw another strong performance from James, earning him the overall Cup win. While the rest of the group did not place as highly, a few managed to bring home some golf balls as consolation.

The group returned on Tuesday afternoon, satisfied and inspired by how a little effort can result in a rich and rewarding experience. The camaraderie was evident, and plans to return next year are already taking shape. The connections made through the Vets Association proved invaluable, and the experience at Bendigo comes highly recommended.
