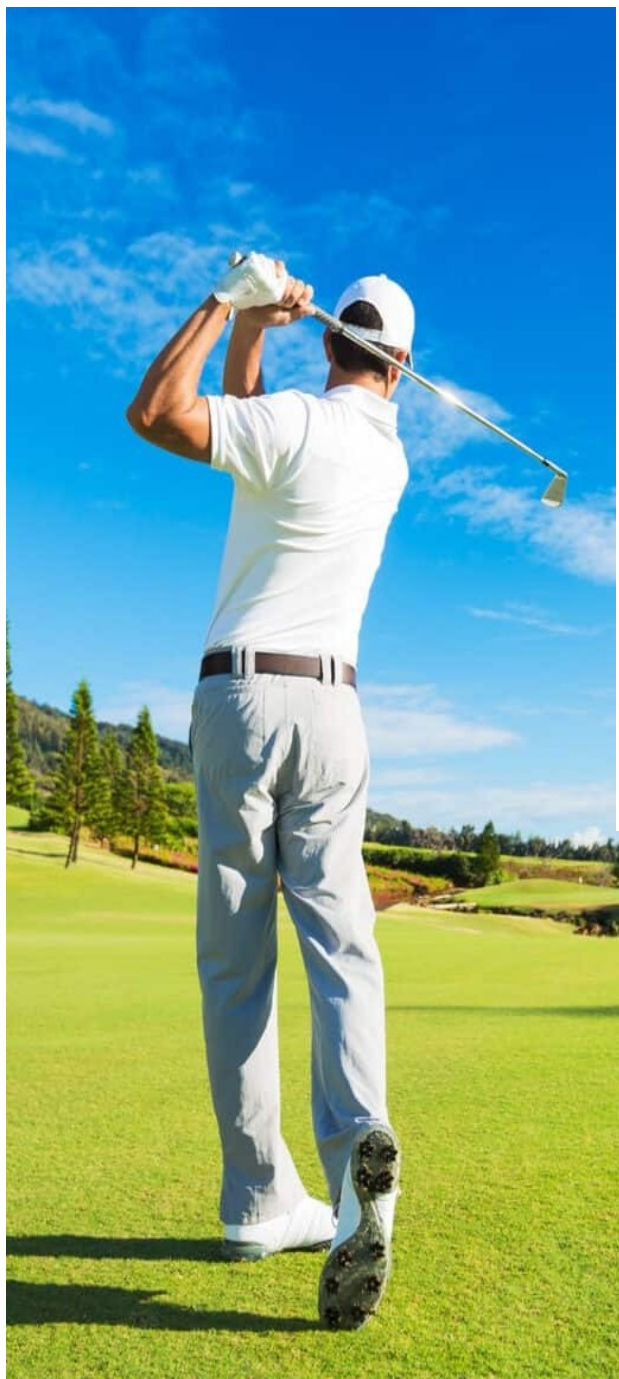

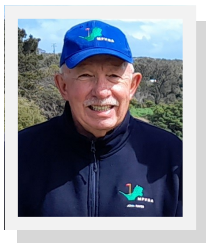

Presidents Report

A colder than cold morning met the players at Flinders, but it all seemed to be put behind us as we battled the conditions with great gusto. Congratulations on those who scored well and to all those like me who just enjoyed the game. Thanks to all Flinders staff who made the day a success and especially our captain Steve Ryan who put the event together.

On 14 -16 September the VVGA teams event at Portland requires two players to Join Gordon Reynolds and his wife Kim and David King and his wife Janet. Without a partner they cannot play. Cost of playing is met by our club . If you can help out let me know by the 26th August – 0425755022

Our next meeting at Moonah will require assistance from you. Please pay online, if at all possible, with Captain Steve away playing in the Australian Veteran Golfers Union event in Darwin. We wish him and his partner Peter Skidmore all the best

Thank you to all who responded to my message about our future.

The executive had a meeting to discuss the responses from interested members following my concerns about the future of our association where increasing costs are causing our attendances to decline.

Fundamentally we must make decisions that will strengthen and grow the membership of the MPVGA.

The following suggestions were put forward for discussion by the committee at our next meeting.
Reduce the number of games from fortnightly to every third week or even once a month.
Reduce the number of games at the high end of costing clubs .

One idea that has been raised and has been implemented for next year is playing a round at Lang Lang where we can play 18 holes as a match against the Gippsland Zone, with lunch at a total cost of \$30 odd. Some might find the travel daunting – members combining travel arrangements may be an answer.

The facts are that the cost of a round of golf on the Mornington Peninsula is not going to decrease in the foreseeable future.

The way forward

First, we must ensure that MPVGA information is available at all Peninsula golf courses so that current golfer can experience the benefits of joining MPVGA -Take home pamphlets are in most golf pro shops – delegates need to check.

One idea for consideration on this is throwing out a broader net for members by targeting specific golf clubs in the sand belt area.

Clubs we could target are Riversdale, Huntingdale, Metropolitan, Commonwealth, Yarra-Yarra, Victoria and even Royal Melbourne.

It was felt that a lot of their members would jump at the opportunity to play on the Mornington Peninsula courses at the reduced rate we are currently paying.

All of the above is for consideration, and your feedback will always be welcome. **Send me a note!!**

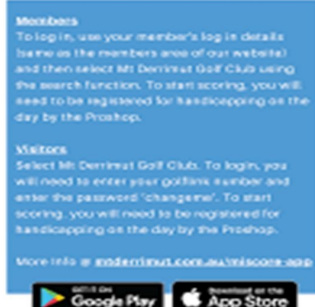
