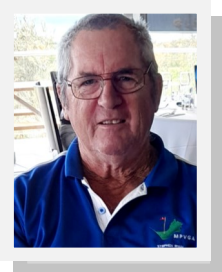

Rosebud Report.

On a glorious Autumn morning, 44 players participated in Stableford at Mornington. The course was in good condition, and the greens good, providing a solid challenge for all golfers.

The winners on the day, A Grade went to Brad Quinn with 39pts and B Grade to Rob Carlton with a great 40pts. Well done to all place getters and ball winners. The pace of play was acceptable with most teams finishing in just over 4 hours.

The next game is at Eagle Ridge on the 12nd of May, with a 2 Tee start from 10 AM and check-in from 9.30AM. The format will be 2 Person Ambrose. Remember if you invite a visitor to any of our games, and they are most welcome, if lunch is available after the game the visitor must pay the full price, usually \$10 dearer than members. This is because we subsidize the lunches for members as a way of giving something back.

The green fees you pay to play most courses is a discounted price for our association. We do endeavour to negotiate a lower price than the shelf price for you. As an example at Rosebud, we paid \$80 green fee plus \$5 comp fee and \$40 for carts. The shelf price for a game on the South Course at Rosebud is \$110 green fee and \$60 Carts.

This will be followed by our Moonah Links Open Course on the 25th of May, with the sheet opening on Wednesday the 13th of May.

For convenience, players are encouraged to pay online before the event. Check your prize or credits online and pay only the difference. To verify your balance, click on member home then prizes.
